## NOTES

1. FORM 1 – KBK – U is only a screener and does not constitute a formal evaluation or diagnosis. If you have concerns about your child having a risk of Specific Learning Differences (SpLD), we recommend that you contact the expert/ specialist about pursuing a more thorough evaluation to investigate the nature of the concerns.
2. FORM 1 – KBK – U consists of 8 questions.
3. Specific Learning Differences (SpLD) here includes:
  - a. Sensory Processing Disorder
  - b. Auditory Processing Disorder
  - c. Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)
  - d. Emotional Behavior Disorder
  - e. Attention Deficit Hyperactive Disorder (ADHD)
  - f. Speech and Language Impairment
  - g. Dyslexia
  - h. Dysgraphia
  - i. Dyscalculia
  - j. Dyspraxia
4. FORM 1 – KBK – U is not suitable for detecting Specific Learning Differences (SpLD) other than those mentioned above.

## HOW TO USE

1. FORM 1 – KBK – U should be filled in by yourself who are suspected of having a risk of dyslexia and 18 – 56 years old. However, if the risk owner is 4-17 years old, this should be filled in by her/his parents / teachers / private tutors.
2. Give a checklist (☒) in the appropriate answer (.....) column.
3. Calculate the total score of the checklist (☒) of the overall answer.  
To carry out further independent pre-diagnosis of the type of Specific Learning Differences (SpLD) risk you have whether it is Dyslexia (Difficulty in Reading), Dysgraphia (Difficulty in Writing), Dyscalculia (Difficulty in Mathematics), and Dyspraxia (Development Coordination Difficulties). Please use the following form:
  1. FORM 2 – D – P for Preschoolers (Age 4 – 6);
  2. FORM 2 – D – S for School Age Children (Age 7 – 17);
  3. FORM 2 – D – D1 for Adults-General (Age 18 – 56);
  4. FORM 2 – D – D2 for Adults-Specific (Age 18 – 56).
